**Dear Parent,**

We warmly greet you on the eve of commencement of class X/XII CBSE 2020 examination and would like to reinforce that we are strongly with your child and you. We are confident that the forthcoming days will bring fulfillment and reward for all of us, as we strive to support our children in this important phase of their academic journey. We urge you to ward off distractions like of any kind and exhibit whole hearted effort and motivation in helping your ward. Remember, your confidence and positivity will boost up the morale of your ward and help him/her to excel.

**Please allow us to make a few suggestions to you which may prove beneficial.**

- Your ward needs positivity, motivation and faith from you rather than stress, questioning and lots of 'why' and 'what' in relation to work done. Replace these questions with 'let's' and constantly repeat your intent to be helpful in any way possible.
- Give them the confidence to present their answers in the answer sheet as beautifully as the food that we prepare is served to our guests in a charming way.
- Ensure that they are not using the mobile phone on these days of exams, as cell phones tended to reduce attention and memory.

**On the previous day of the examination please ensure the following things:**

- Keep the exam related things handy one day in advance e.g. Admit Card, pens, pencil, eraser, sharpener, scale etc. to avoid last minute rush. Carry the stationary in a transparent pouch.
- The student should attempt a mock examination on the previous day or two days before the examination so that he /she can get a feel of the real examination.
- All the important chapters must be revised before going to bed.
- Don't overburden the brain. After every 35 minutes take a break of 5 minutes so that he/she can refresh the brain & increase its efficiency.
- Refrain from last minute preparation.
- On the previous night of the examination let the child visualize the positive outcome of the examination; very easy paper, scoring high marks etc. to generate confidence in the subconscious mind.
- Don't study at late night on the previous day of the examination.

**On the day of the examination:**

- Kindly ensure that the child wakes up & starts the day with a positive visualization once again, which will boost your positivity and confidence.





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- He/she is ready with all the materials required to be carried to the examination hall (stationery and admit card). Ensure, he/ she has a healthy breakfast. Make sure that your ward feels blessed and strong with your blessings while stepping out of the house.
- Reach the school half an hour early. The students who are going along with their parents to the exam centre i.e. Carmel School (Centre No: 9014) must report there by 7.00 a.m. Check the location of the exam centre at least a day prior to the Exam.
- Wear the school uniform & ID card.
- After reaching the exam hall no need for any further discussions & don't laugh too much as it will result in losing focus on the examination.

## **Exam timings of CBSE Board Exam 2020:**

Answer books would be distributed between 7:30 - 7:45 AM.

Question paper will be distributed at 7:45 AM.

From 7:45 - 8:00 AM (15 minutes), candidates shall read the question paper.

After 8:00 AM; students can write answers in their answer booklets. The exams will be over at 11:00 AM.

- Fill OMR Sheet very carefully. Keep the admit card in front & enter the details accordingly. Keep the methodology emphasized by school to put your 8 digit roll number carefully.
- Utilise the reading time effectively.
- Start with the most confident questions & attempt the difficult ones later.
- For better time management, allot specific time to different sections.
- Wrist watch must be taken along for better time management.
- Use the last 10 minutes to review the paper & then only hand it over. Make sure not to leave any answer unattempted.

Avoid discussion of the question paper after the conclusion of the exam. Listen closely rather than question closely and encourage your ward to move on to the next paper with confidence of your support.

Children grow and mature differently and as their guardians at home and school, let's join hands to communicate and make visible our support, love and faith.

We look forward to celebrating with you and your wonderful child when the CBSE result comes out in May 2020.
