#### IMPORTANCE OF SCIENCE EDUCATION IN SCHOOLS



In the words of Thomas Edison "The greatest invention in the world is the mind of a child." Every child is born with the instinct of curiosity. We all come into the world with a natural inquisitiveness, waiting to explore and investigate, trying to find answers to the questions we've asked. Society expects much from its schools - both in terms of general education and vocational training. There is wide spread concern about the outcomes of science education at school. Every country is striving to improve the quality of teaching of science in schools.

What are the ways to improve the scientific skills?

Science links textual knowledge with their everyday experiences. It develops a basic understanding about scientific procedures and experiments. The innovative, simple projects explore and explain the wonders of scientific world. Science should not be read but should be practised by collecting evidences and evaluating the result. Students can exercise their thinking skills from the content of the curriculum. Teachers can use new methodology like oral and written work, project and power point presentation. We can develop a scientific temper in solving problems in our day today life. Students themselves can perform science experiments and practicals so that they themselves can undergo scientific process such as identification of problems, formulae, hypotheses, experimentations, collection of data and drawing inferences on the basis of data obtained.

Spirit of team work, rational thinking, acceptance of other's ideas, open mindedness, communication skill and manipulation of equipments will be inculcated in the students from an earlier stage. Experimentation by the students also provides Learning by Doing. Students can participate in inter school science exhibitions; perform science projects in the most prestigious science fairs and science Olympiads. They can also learn by activities, conduct debates or discuss and have higher order thinking questions. Science develops procedural, manipulative, observational, drawing, reporting and interpretative skills.

"You cannot teach a man anything; you can only help him discover it in himself "says Albert Einstein the famous Nobel prize winner and great scientist. I wish you all the very best for the success and future endeavours of our students. Enjoy learning in school.


